

# **Safety Instructions**


## Thanks for purchasing E-IMAGE E-MOTUS products.


We encourage you to read this manual carefully to familiarize all the details features before operation, some of which maybe new to you. The manual including all safety instructions, operation, maintance. Please make sure that all equipments is operated correctly to avoid any defects or damage, especially the tripods should be steady and the head is locked tightly and levelling.


- 1. Please don't exceed the max. payload of head.
- 2. Please lock the tripod leg tightly before mounting camera on.
- 3. Please make sure the head is locked tightly on the tripod.
- 4. Please add accessories on the camera before adjusting balance.
- 5.Please don't leave the camera on fluid head unattended on the fluid head, keep it out of children.
- 6. Please don't adjust the height of tripod while the camera is on.
- 7. Please keep the quick release plate locked during using.
- 8.Please keep the tilt & pan is locked when adding/removing accessories from camera.
- 9. Please hold the camera securely during adjusting balance, counterbalance, tilt drag and pan drag.
- 10. Please remove the camera from tripods for transportation.


## **MH22 Counterbalance Chart**




# Fluid Head Set-up

## 1 Attach the head on the tripod.




- 1-1: Please make sure the tripod leg is placed approximately in horizon and tripod leg are locked tightly.
- 1-2: Place the Head into the tripod bowl, then locking the bowl knob, meanwhile using the bubble level to set the head in level (the bulb in the circle), finally lock the bowl knob tightly.
- 1-3: Please lock the pan and tilt knob tightly.

## 2 Assemble or Dis-assmble the QR plate.



2-0: Before assembling the plate on, please press the plate release button to make sure the plate fix block back in correct position (raised).



## 2-1: Assemble (a&b)


Please press the QR plate on to the platform until "click" is heard, adjust it in appropriate place, then lock the QR plate release lever until the plate safety button is engaged.

## 2-2: Dis-assemble (c&d)


- c:Press the plate safety button in, meanwhile, release the plate release lever by pulling it out.
- d: Press the plate insurance button and take out the QR plate.

## **8** Attach the handle.




- 3-1: Install the pan handle on the rosette handle mounts and adjust the position before tightening the clamps.
- 3-2: Release the knob and adjust the length as you want , then re-lock it.

# **Camera Mounting**



- 1-1: Attach the quick release plate to the bottom of the camera using the camera screws and pin supplied. Please make sure lock the screws tightly.
- 1-2: Hold the camera with one hand, press the camera on the platform. Slide forwards until the safety mechanism is engaged.
- 1-3: Slide the camera to appropriate position then locking the plate releasing lever until the safety button is engaged.
- 1-4: If the camera adapter with V-lock is needed, please assemble the adapter on plate at first, then attach the camera on adapter.
- 1-5: Attach the camera accessories on, like lens, focus control, viewfinder ect.




# **Balance Adjustment**

 $\triangle$ 


The center of gravity of the camera should be centered precisely over the axis of fluid head. Please kindly understand that unbalanced payload maybe will fall away suddenly to damage the camera.

- \* Please make sure that camera and all accessories are installed before this operation.
- \* Please always maintain a firm hold on the camera until balance is achieved.




- 1-1: Adjust the counterbalance to about 30-50%.
- 1-2: Please lock the tilt locking knob, dial the titl drag to "0".
- ★ (PS: Be prepared to prevent the camera fall down suddenly. Please increase the counterbalance setting depend on actual situation).


# **Balance Adjustment**



- 1-3: Please hold the camera or pan handle securely in level, then release the tilt locking knob and observe how camera moves.
- a: If the camera stops in horizon, the balance is achieved.



b: If the camera is fall forward (lens points downwards), please carefully slide the quick release plate in backwards.




- C: If the camera is fall backforward (lens points upwards), please carefully slide the quick release plate in forwards.(PS: if necessary, please adjust the camera location on the plate).
- \* Please repate the operation until the camera could stay in horizontal position. Then lock the tilt knob tightly.


# **Counterbalance Setting**

The counterbalance system was designed to neutralise the effect of the camera weight when it is tilted. If the correct counterbalance is achieved, the camera should remain in any tilt position, and it could be moved by minimum effort in tilt.


\*Please make sure that camera and all accessories are installed before this operation.



- 1-1: Please always hold the handle, set the counterbalance to about 50%.
- 1-2: Loose the tilt locking knob, tilt the camera upwards or downwards 45° and release it.
- a: If the camera stays in the same position, the camera is balanced correctly.




b:If camera falls forward (lens points upwards),please decrease the counterbalance by turning the counterbalance handle counterclockwise as required.



- c:If cameras falls downward(lens points downwards), please increase the counterbalance by turning the counterbalance handle clockwise as required.
- \* Please repeat the operation until the correct counterbalance is achieved. Fine turning can be achieved by adjusting the camera plate.

# **Setting Of The Damping**



#### 1-1: Tilt drag:

MH22: 4 steps, MH32:8 steps. Please dial the tilt drag knob to your desired level.


#### 1-2: Pan drag:

MH22: 4 steps, MH32:8 steps. Please dia the pan drag knob to your desired level.

\* Make sure that you always turn the setting to the correct indexed position(arrow), not between the indexed positions.

## **Pan And Tilt Locks**

The pan and tilt locks should be engaged whenever the camera is left unattended.



## 1-1: Lock the pan lock


Turn the pan lock lever clockwise to lock it.

## 1-2: Lock the tilt lock

Turn the tilt lock lever clockwise to lock it.

## **Illuminated The Bubble Level**

Press the button, it will help you level the head in poor light. The bubble will be light up to 20s.




# **Removing The Camera**

# **Battery Replacement**


The battery illuminates the bubble level. It should be replaced whenever the illumination becomes inadequate.

- 1.Use a coin or flat blade screwdriver to unscrew the battery cover.
- 2. Carefully pull the battery out of its compartment.
- 3.Fit a replacement 192/LR41 (AG3) battery in the compartment, ensuring that the positive side (+) of the battery faces outermost.
- 4. Replace the battery cover and tighten using a coin or flat blade screwdriver.
- 5. Press the bubble level illumination button and verify that the bubble level is lit for approximately 20 seconds.


## Loose & lock leg tube (For ECT100).



Loose: Turn the locking knob "C" anti-clockwise.


Lock: Turn the locking knob "C" clockwise until tight.

## Height adjustment (For ECT100M / 100L).




- a: Please pull the flip lock lever up to slide the tube up and down.
- b: Push down th flip lock lever to fix the height.

## Loose & lock middle spreader (For the EI-7000L).



a: Assemble & Release middle.



b:Loose -Turn the locking knob "C" anti-clockwise.

Lock -Turn the locking knob "C" clockwise until tight.

c :Adjust the angle.

## **Daily maintenance**

## Storage and transport:

When not using head for a long time, please turn all the knobs to the minimum.

When not using tripod, please don't place vertically to avoid the broken.

When not using tripod or transportation, please keep it in the carry bag.

## **Function inspection:**

Please check the tripod payload and head locking condition, in order to avoid the accident. Please check and adjust tripod and head locking condition regularly, in order to increase service life.

## **Function inspection:**

- 1. Using a regular with a lint-free cloth to clean tripods.
- 2. Please keep it in carrying case if not use it for long time.
- 3. Using a semi-stiffe brush or vacuum.

Always engage safety locks and devices where applicable on the products.

Don't use product at temperatures less than  $-30^{\circ}$  or more than  $+60^{\circ}$ . Cleaning with mild detergent and a soft cloth. Remove dust and sand from all locking threads and sliding segments. Dry the product after use in wet conditions.

IMPORTANT: Not recommended to use in seawater.

If any questions during using process, please read the instruction carefully or ask help from your local distributor.
